Tri-Counties Regional Center is soliciting proposals for the following Purchase of Service (POS) contracted service:

**Date:** July 3, 2014

**Service Type:** Service Code 805, Infant Development Program

**Reimbursement:** Temporary Payment Rate, as determined by the Department of Developmental

Services (DDS) less current State-mandated discount

**Location:** Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo Counties

### **Service Description:**

An Infant Development Program is a multi-disciplinary program serving infants and toddlers under the age of 3 years with a developmental delay in areas of cognitive, physical/motor, communication, social/emotional, and /or adaptive development. Services typically include one or more of the following: speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy. (Please note that Infant Development Programs shall not include behavior services.)

## **General Requirements:**

- Program must meet all applicable requirements of Title 17 regulations.
- Program must offer evening and weekend hours to accommodate working parents.
- Staff must possess license/credential/academic degree (Master's) for the service they will provide.
- Service must be provided in natural environments.
- Staff must speak the language of the family they support.

- d) Briefly describe your plan to recruit, train, and retain quality staff. Include:
  - Desired characteristics for all staff positions
  - Health and criminal background screening procedures
  - Initial and ongoing training, including required licensure/certifications.
  - Plan to recruit/develop Spanish-speaking staff.
- e) Preference will be given to programs:
  - In which direct service staff receive at least monthly face-to-face supervision.
  - That have the capability to provide instruction in Spanish
